# Planning and Land Use Committee

5 A). Motion The LHNC Planning Committee requests permission of the LHNC Board to contact Council member Gilbert Cedillo concerning a complaint by one of our constituents regarding a) a restaurant with possible health violations b) residents who are not artists living in spaces zoned for artists in residence and c) manufacturing in spaces zoned for artists.

Victoria moves and Vincent seconds the motion. Sevin stated that Richard Larson is concerned at what appears to be a departure from the original zoning arrangement for artist in residence. Mario Marrufo understands the concern however does not think we can make recommendations or suggestions if we do not know what the zoning is. Vera does not think there is a problem with simply asking. We are not looking to fight or to write a letter of support at all.

Committee discussed what options there could be, including a stop sign. The sign can be solar operated showing people what their speed is. Would like to recommend this to Gilbert Cedillo.
