### City Reports

Jose Rodriguez: Deputy Distric Director with CD1. Unfortunately there was a fatality this week. They will be adding additional lighting to the exterior of Lincoln Park. They also want to add a camera system if funding allows. The Lincoln Park Recreation Center has a swimming pool, there will be a groundbreaking to start the construction of the swimming pool early this summer. Mr. Rodriguez also brought a copy of the 1Voice magazine for the Winter edition. Next Wednesday at LA Prep at 5:30pm will be the 1Voice reception.

<u>Joe Perez</u>: SLO for Lincoln Heights. Last year there were 12 homocides, 4 were in LH and 3 were solved. One is outstanding which is the one that happened across EL ARCA at the park. There were a lot of property crimes in LH. SLO reminds everyone to be careful with leaving belongings inside vehicles. Car seat exchange is happening on Saturday January 30<sup>th</sup>. They will give new ones out if families have car seats that are not functional or not the right size for their child. It starts at 2pm at the Hollenbeck Station. Body cameras were received by the department. They are supposed to go citywide but it will cost over \$50 million dollars.

<u>Pauline Martinez</u>: Farmers Market is proud to announce they will hire their first ever high school student. There are a lot of LH residents who grow their own fruits and vegetables and they are looking into the possibility of having these residents have a non-certified booth.
