City Reports

Albion Park Update:

Security and break-ins continue to be a concern for project.

City and Contractor have discussed security with the RAP rangers and LAPD. Police reports have been filed.

The contractor has added the following security measures:

- cameras, alarms, and lighting have been installed in the area of the trailers
- a private security firm patrols the site during the evenings

Perimeter lighting surrounding the Downey Rec center is helping.

Demolition of the sidewalk, curb and gutter on Albion St. is complete. Construction of the new parking lot with permeable pavers has begun.

The contractor started installing various underground utilities and conduits throughout the site.

Ave 26/ Humboldt Traffic Signal Update

Construction will start the week of March 26 and should be completed by late June

Construction includes moving water meters, adding ramps, installing underground utilities, moving bus stop to opposite corner, etc to be coordinated w/ DWP and METRO.
