Expenses incurred include musicians and a DJ, gym use permit, porta-potties, water and snacks, postage, paper goods, etc. The event is held at Mexico Park in Lincoln Heights the last Saturday of each February. More than 300 indigenous dancers, singers, musicians, artisans of all ages gather for this 3-day traditional celebration to honor the last Aztec leader, Cuauhtemoc. The Saturday event takes place at his statue in Mexico Park, which was diffed to the City of Los Angeles in 1978.

This is a free public event. The community benefits by the interaction, education, and entertainment offered by the indigenous as they practice age-old traditions in a public venue. The public can choose to participate by interacting with community dancers and will receive a sense of our historical ties to our beautiful indigenous culture.
