Planning 101 workshops for NC Land Use Committees


Per the [Board of Neighborhood Commissioners' Leadership Orientation Policy](#) & the City Council's [NC Reform 18-0467 #4](#), EmpowerLA and the Department of City Planning were instructed to design and implement a mandatory planning and land use management training, required of current and future Neighborhood Council Planning and Land Use (PLUM) Committee members.

Any individual who intends to serve on an NC land use committee must complete the training within 60 days of appointment or confirmation. Current PLUM committee members are required to complete the "Project Planning 101" training by **December 16, 2020**. An individual who fails to complete the training within the applicable 60-day period will be automatically ineligible to serve as a member of the land use committee.

The Department of City Planning is conducting live (virtual) Planning 101 trainings. NC PLUM committee members are encouraged to take one of the three "live" Project Planning training webinars offered on **October 13th, 15th and 17th**. This will satisfy the Commission's and City Council's mandate. If attending the live training, committee members must attend for the full 1.5 hours to receive credit. If they are unable to attend the live training, online training will be available within the next few weeks.
