Dear Los Angeles City Clerk:

Lincoln Heights Neighborhood Council has written over a dozen Community Impact Statements (CIS) as of 9/2/21. Most have been successfully added to the council files by the City Clerk after upload to the CIS portal. However, four LHNC Community Impact statements are MIA. We've uploaded these statements again after noticing their absence. Still, they fail to appear on the CFMS. The cases are as follows: CF 20-1314 TOC Revisions (Cedillo), CF 21-0709 William Mead Homes (Cedillo), CF 21-0690 El Recreo Room, CF 20-1529 San Antonio Winery Banners (de Leon).

These items are going to council soon, in a matter of days and we have waited months for these Community Impact Statements to appear on the council files. Usually it takes one or two days. We possess confirmation emails stating successful upload to the system- yet no CIS appear. Mysteriously enough, one that has been particularly difficult is the TOC CIS which the councilman had written about our community. That CIS was uploaded in June three times to the correct outlets but is nowhere to be seen. We are suspicious that there could be some interference/ obstruction occurring.

Lincoln Heights Neighborhood Council asks the LA City Clerk to provide answers as to the status of our missing Community Impact Statements. Our council and stakeholders need to be assured that censorship is not the issue at hand.
